When David was 6 years old, his mother developed an illness that confined her to a wheelchair. Her illness had a big influence on his singing style since early childhood. A natural feeling for sad songs and an inner sadness about his mother's health put an edge of maturity in his voice beyond his 22 years of age.

Maturity beyond his years gives David the necessary ingredient usually missing from most of the young artists' vocal deliveries.

When David hits the stage with his seven piece self-contained band, his stature of 6 feet, 3 inches with cowboy hat and boots create a visual image that he is larger than life. He commands attention when he performs, and the audience celebrates the talent.

But is he good enough?

When you attend your first David Snowden performance, you will soon discover he is good enough for his audience, and the audience will never be satisfied. They will always want more.
